During Easter week, we did a very important and good thing - we distributed food kits to crisis families in the village of Borova, as they are called in the village council. These are families with a disabled child, large families, families with deceased and missing military personnel, and pensioners over 80 years old with a minimum pension. Of course, before the distribution, there was a meeting with the supplier, a discussion of the discount, delivery, and the list of products. Then another meeting regarding the final confirmation of the order and payment. Then the goods were received, packaged, and stickers with information about our organization were applied. And on the last day before my departure, the distribution of the kits. 530 euros were spent on 50 food kits. The kit included: buckwheat, peas, rice, pasta, 1 kg sugar, 1 liter royal flavor oil, 100 packs of tea, 2 chocolates, beef stew. 500g. People were very grateful. And I convey their gratitude to you, to those who help hold events where we collect donations. Who hold classes in clubs, collecting donations from visitors. I am grateful to our visitors who donate, with which we can provide assistance to those in need in Ukraine. Together we support those who remained in Ukraine and show them that they have not been forgotten, that they are cared for.
