

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy informs users about the type, scope, and purposes of the collection and use of personal data by Jeremias Steinmann on this website (hereinafter referred to as "Website").

1. Responsible Entity under Data Protection Laws

2. Collection and Processing of Personal Data

Legal Basis:

Processing is based on your consent in accordance with Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR.

3. Third-Party Analytics Tools

Hotjar allows us to visualize user interactions, helping us identify issues and friction points to improve our services. To provide these insights, Hotjar uses first-party cookies and other technologies to collect personal data on our users' behavior and devices on our behalf. This may include:

- · Online identifiers (e.g., device's IP address, user ID)
- · Identification data (e.g., name, email address—only if explicitly collected)
- · Technical data (e.g., device type and screen size, browser information)
- · Geographic location (country only)
- · Behavioral data (e.g., interactions with our website/app such as clicks, taps, scrolls)
- · Any additional personal data explicitly submitted through Hotjar

Hotjar may reuse this personal data to develop and improve tools and services for us and our users.
