Non finalized movement - awaiting means of transport:

(S) The above named, a refugee from racial oppression in Poland, bearer of a Polish passport, has been referred to us by HIAS of AMERICA, Prague, who write:

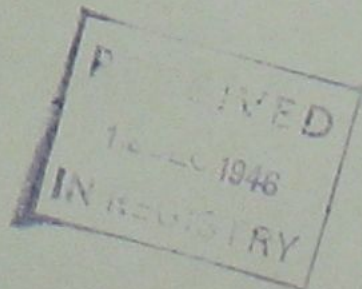
"The above mentioned is in possession of a tourist visa, valid 6 months, to Paraguay, which according to our information from the Paraguayan consul could be easily turned into an immigration visa, when 50 dollars are paid on the spot. In this he should be helped by Mr. Winicki and Mr. Solnicki, his close friends, who were saved together with him from the concentration camp and who have promised, under any circumstances not to let him down in Paraguay. Therefore we ask you kindly to look into this matter and grant him financial and technical help. "

We are, therefore, including Mr. Maks NOVINSKY in the Migration-Settlement Scheme and - pending receipt from you of the Special forms which we shall then fill in for each applicant and return to you - we would thank you to let us have authorization to pay the travel expenses to Paraguay for the above named Maks Novinsky.



Mr. Hans NOVINSKY has proved to be victim of Nazi persecution. He is in possession of a valid Polish passport and of entry visa to Paraguay. We have already received from Headquarters the necessary approval to cover all transport - costs from Prague. As Mr. Novinsky is already several weeks in Czechoslovakia his temporary permit of residence might not be extended and we would therefore be very grateful if you could let us know by cable whether and when you could include him into a transport to South America.


