

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains how personal data is processed when you visit this website and when you register or communicate in connection with our community meetups.

1. Controller

2. Applicable Law

We process personal data in accordance with the **EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR – Regulation (EU) 2016/679)** and the **Maltese Data Protection Act (Chapter 586)**.

3. Personal Data We Process and Purposes

a) Website access (server logs)

When you access this website, technical data may be processed, including:

- IP address (or parts thereof, depending on configuration)
- date and time of access
- pages accessed / requested files
- referrer URL
- browser type and version, operating system
- device and technical information required to deliver the website

Purpose:

Providing the website, ensuring stability and security, and troubleshooting errors.

Legal basis:

Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR – legitimate interests in operating a secure and reliable website.

b) Registration / contact via forms or email

When you register for a meetup or contact us, we process the data you provide, in particular:

- first name
- last name
- email address
- any information you voluntarily include in your message

Purpose:

Managing registrations, organisational communication (e.g. confirmations, updates),

responding to enquiries and, where applicable, initiating or managing a contractual relationship.

Legal basis:

Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR – pre-contractual measures / contract and, where applicable, Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR – legitimate interest in efficient communication and organisation.

4. Hosting and Website Platform (Onepage)

This website is created and hosted using **Onepage** (Onepage GmbH, Hanauer Landstraße 172, 60314 Frankfurt am Main, Germany).

Onepage processes personal data on our behalf as a **data processor** for hosting, technical operation, website delivery and form functionality.

Data is generally processed within the EU/EEA. Where transfers outside the EU/EEA occur, appropriate contractual safeguards are applied where required.

5. Cookies

We use **strictly necessary cookies or similar technologies** to operate and secure this website and to provide essential functions.

Where additional cookies or comparable technologies require consent, such consent will be requested before such processing takes place.

6. Data Sharing and Recipients

We do not sell personal data.

Personal data is shared only:

- with service providers acting on our instructions (e.g. hosting and website platform providers),
- where legally required, or
- where necessary to establish, exercise or defend legal claims.

7. International Data Transfers

If personal data is transferred outside the EU/EEA in specific cases, such transfers are carried out in compliance with applicable law, e.g. based on an adequacy decision or appropriate safeguards such as Standard Contractual Clauses.

8. Data Retention

Personal data is retained only as long as necessary for the purposes described:

- **Server logs:** retained for a limited period required for security and troubleshooting
- **Registrations and enquiries:** retained as long as needed to handle the enquiry, organise the meetup, and any resulting relationship, and longer only if required by law or for legal claims

9. Security

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data against accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorised disclosure or access.

Data transmissions are generally encrypted (HTTPS), where supported.

10. Your Rights

Subject to applicable law, you have the right to:

- access your personal data
- request rectification
- request erasure
- request restriction of processing
- request data portability
- object to processing based on legitimate interests
- withdraw consent at any time where processing is based on consent
