<Description>Introduction of one focused topic (e.g., greetings, ordering food, asking for directions). Explained in German. Key phrases presented clearly.</Description>

<Name>Konversationsübung (6 min)</Name>
<Description>Sofia leads a short simulated conversation using the new phrases. Bianca responds. Sofia gently corrects and encourages. Role-play scenarios are practical and realistic.</Description>

<Name>Abschluss & Ausblick (2 min)</Name>
<Description>Summary of what was learned. One phrase to remember until the next session. Preview of the next topic.</Description>

Full German explanation. Spanish phrases introduced one at a time. Focus: greetings, numbers, colors, basic questions.

Mixed language: German explanations, increasing Spanish interaction. Focus: daily life situations, simple sentences.

Predominantly Spanish during exercises. German only for clarification. Focus: fluid mini-conversations, listening comprehension.
